Theme: "Smart & Sustainable — Building Odisha as India's Eastern Oilseed Hub" Date & Venue: 24 November 2025 | MAYFAIR Convention, Bhubaneswar

Background

India imports nearly 60 % of its edible-oil requirements, valued at over ≥ 1.5 lakh crore (2022–23). At the same time, more than half of India's oilseed area suffers from soil degradation, low productivity, and climate stress. To address this challenge, **SEA of India** and **Solidaridad Asia** have established the **National Alliance for Regenerative Vegetable Oil Sector (NARVOS)** – a multi-stakeholder platform dedicated to scaling regenerative oilseed production through coordinated policy, research, and industry action.



Odisha, endowed with 11.7 lakh hectares of rice fallows, ten agro-climatic zones, and emerging cotton and groundnut belts, is strategically positioned to become the next growth frontier for India's oilseed sector. The joint study by **Solidaridad Asia and SEA**, "From Field to Fortune," maps a clear pathway for a dedicated **Odisha Edible Oil Mission (2025–30)** to convert rice fallows into productive, climateresilient oilseed areas

It aims to unite farmers, industry, government, research, and civil society to revitalize India's vegetable-oil sector through regenerative agriculture practices that enhance soil health, climate resilience, and farmer income.







About the Study: From Field to Fortune

The Solidaridad-SEA study proposes a five-year Odisha Edible Oil Mission (₹1,525 crore) to convert 9.8 lakh ha into oilseed areas, close the 58 % yield gap, and create 100-150 FPOs. The plan could generate ₹49,410 crore in economic output and ₹6,770 crore in revenue to the state, while bridging 5.4 % of India's edible-oil deficit by 2030.
